AND CHICAGO**

Chicago July 22^d 1848

Eng. Illinois & Mic Canal

Sir:

I will do the towing
on the Illinois and Michigan Canal between
the City of Chicago and Bridgeport for Eighteen
dollars per day, and optional with you as to
the starting hour and the number of trips pr day.

I will leave Grand River on wednesday next and
will be here as soon as wind and weather will permit.

Enclosed I send you a letter of introduction to
Robert Stuart, also a certificate of responsibility.

If you should see fit to accept this proposal,
please imform me by letter at the Tremont, or I will
call and see you at the Sherman House on
Monday Morning at 7 o'clock
