

DOCUMENT 40 – ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE SANITARY COMMISSION

April 10, 1862

TRANSCRIPTION

An Ordinance making an appropriation
for the relief of suffering soldiers
Common Council of
Be it Ordained by the City of Chicago

Section 1 That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars
be and hereby is appropriated from the
amount in the City Treasury collected by
taxation as a War Fund, for the purpose
of affording relief to our sick and wounded
soldiers the same to be expended under
the direction of the Chicago branch of
the U S Sanitary Commission

Section 2 That the City Comptroller be and hereby
is directed to draw a Warrant on the
City Treasurer favor of Hon Mark Skinner
President of the Chicago Branch of the
U.S Sanitary Commission for five thousand
and deliver the immediately
same to him to be used for the purpose
of affording relief ~~to the Soldiers wounded~~
~~in recent as~~ as the Commission may
think proper to our sick and wounded
soldiers ~~immediately~~ and deliver the other
Five thousand Dollars to him for the same
purpose ~~if he should~~ when he shall
state it is required

The Council then adjourned
