Dr Sir

we the undersigned Property

Street do ask of you to put a stop to the
erection of a Base Ball Park that is
been erected on the corner of 12th and
Lincoln St as we think it will be
an injurey and nuisance to the
neighborhood as it will be a resort for
loafers and desreputable characters
on sunday afternoons and as their
is a Ball Park at the farther end
of 12th St now we think this is
plenty without erecting one in this
thickley populated neighborhood and
as it is near our churches and schools
we think it would be a temptation
to our children and by stoping them
