Chicago May 25/75

To the Hon Board of Aldermen
of City of Chicago

We the Teachers of the Holden

School – do beg leave to present to your Hon Body
that —

Whereas there is an average daily attendance
of over 800 children &

Whereas we are in the direct rout in which
Texas and other wild cattle are driven
from the stockyard to the slaughterHouses on
Archer Ave and

Whereas the lives of those children are
in daily peril from that source

Therefore we pray that your Hon Body
will extend to us & those children ~~the~~
that protiction which the case demands
by the passage of an ordinance prohibiting
the driving of said cattle through our
streets between such hours of the day as will
Insure us protection
