Vanity/Personalized Plates

- No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after a plate has been ordered or if the request form is incorrectly completed.
- The Secretary of State's office is authorized to recall a plate determined to be obscene or offensive.
- All request forms should indicate whether or not you want the Secretary of State to assign one of your choices with the next available number if your exact request is unavailable.
- If you wish to submit more than three requests, attach additional selections to the request form.

DO NOT

- Intermix letters and numbers
- Use a space between numbers
- Use lower-case letters
- Use characters, symbols, foreign words or symbols of punctuation, such as dashes or periods
- Select obscene or offensive combinations

First-Time Registrations

- Money must accompany request forms on all first-time registrations.
- A leased vehicle is eligible for vanity or personalized plates.

Every day, law enforcement officers across the state serve and protect the people of Illinois, often putting their lives on the line. Sadly, some of these brave men and women die in the line of duty.

To honor these courageous men and women and salute our fallen police officers, an Illinois Police Memorial was erected on the northeast grounds of the Capitol Complex and dedicated in October 1990. For more than two decades, police officers from across the state have gathered in Springfield for the annual Illinois Police Memorial ceremony in May to honor their fallen comrades, whose names are added to the memorial.

To help honor our police officers, my office offers Police Memorial License Plates. Proceeds from the sale of these plates help support the maintenance and annual commemoration of the Illinois Police Memorial as well as provide scholarships for children of police officers killed in the line of duty.

I encourage you to show your support of our police officers by displaying a set of Police Memorial plates on your vehicle.

Registration and Fee Information

Police Memorial License Plates are multi-year and may be displayed on passenger vehicles, B-trucks and vans weighing 8,000 pounds or less.

To purchase Police Memorial plates, please submit the appropriate plates request form along with your license plates registration or renewal application and the following applicable fees:

(\$95 title fee, \$99 registration fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee)
- Currently titled vehicle/first-time issuance — \$124
(\$99 registration fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee)
- Current plates expire within 90 days — \$153
(\$99 registration fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Current plates do not expire within 90 days — \$54
(\$25 Police Memorial plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Annual renewal — \$124
(\$99 registration fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee)

(\$94 vanity fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Annual renewal — \$137
(\$99 registration fee, \$13 vanity fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee)

(\$47 personalized fee, \$25 Police Memorial plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
