Jesse White Announces New Driver Services Facility Location in Watseka
Facility expected to open Feb. 5

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White announced today that the new Driver Services facility in Watseka will be located at 123 W. Walnut St. and is expected to be open for business on Tuesday, Feb. 5. The new facility is nearly 2,500 square feet which is more than 1,000 square feet larger than the previous facility. The old facility, located at 1400 E. Walnut, will close after business on Tuesday, Jan. 29.

“The new facility in Watseka is conveniently located – approximately two miles from the previous facility – and is much more spacious for the residents of Watseka,” said White. “As our lease at the previous facility was set to expire and the owners of that space wished to move in a different direction, it was my priority to find a new location in Watseka.”

White’s office has been working with the landlord who, as part of the 10-year lease agreement, is in charge of making necessary modifications to the building. These modifications, standard when opening a Driver Services facility at a new site, are designed to maximize the facility’s traffic flow and efficiency.
