**Secretary of State's Driver Services Facilities and Offices to be Closed North of I-80 Thursday
Due to Hazardous and Extreme Weather Conditions**
Facilities and Offices South of I-80 to be Open; No Morning Road Tests

The Secretary of State facilities and offices located north of I-80 will be closed Thursday, Jan. 31 due to dangerously cold temperatures while downstate facilities will be open. Road tests at those facilities will not be conducted in the morning.

With vehicle stickers due at the end of the month, the public is encouraged to purchase stickers online. Drivers can print out the receipt as proof of purchase until the sticker is mailed which is accepted by law enforcement.

Facilities that are closed in the Chicago area include:

Aurora, Bridgeview, Chicago Loop Express, Chicago Central, Chicago Diversey Express, Chicago Heights, Chicago North, Chicago Public Service Center, Chicago South, Chicago West, Deerfield, Des Plaines, Elgin, Joliet, Lake Zurich, Lockport Express, Lombard, Melrose Park, Midlothian, Naperville, Orland Park, Plano, Schaumburg, Waukegan, Wheaton Express, Woodstock, Elk Grove CDL, South Holland CDL, and West Chicago CDL.

Additional facilities that are closed include: Silvis, Princeton, Kewanee, Chadwick, Galena, Freeport, Sterling, Dixon, Oregon, Rockford Central, Rockford Express, Rockford CDL, Roscoe, Belvedere, DeKalb, Mendota, LaSalle, Ottawa, Streator, and Morris.
