McLeansboro Driver Services Facility Reopens Thursday, August 6

The McLeansboro Driver Services Facility (1105 E. Randolph St. 101) reopens Thursday, August 6 after closing as a precaution because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19. The facility has been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.

This facility will not be conducting road tests until August 18, 2020. During this same time period, the facility will be closed for lunch from noon until 1 p.m.

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White reiterated to the public that expiration dates for driver's licenses/ID cards and vehicle registration stickers have been extended until Nov. 1, 2020 so customers do not need to rush into a facility. During hot weather it is suggested that customers consider delaying their visit, but if a customer must visit a facility, they are encouraged to come prepared to wait outside due to social distancing, which limits the number of people inside a facility at one time.

Customers are also encouraged to conduct transactions online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com if possible. Those who do business online will not have to wait in line at a facility.

Customers and Secretary of State employees are required to wear face masks and social distancing measures are in place.
