**Fairfield and McLeansboro Driver Services Facilities Closed
Until August 5 and 6 Respectively**

Out of an abundance of caution, the Fairfield Driver Services Facility (307 N. Market St.) is closed until August 5 and the McLeansboro Driver Services Facility (1105 E. Randolph St. 101) is closed until August 6 as a precaution because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19.

The Illinois Department of Public Health has been consulted and confirmed that the public is not directly impacted by this situation. Employees who work at the facilities are being quarantined for 14 days and the facilities are scheduled to be cleaned and sanitized according to CDC guidelines.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended all expiration dates to Nov. 1, 2020 for driver's licenses/ID cards and license plate stickers so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

White encourages people to conduct business online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com such as renewing license plate stickers, obtaining replacement driver's licenses/ID cards as well as safe driver renewals.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required and people are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.

Drivers can visit the nearest facilities which include Mt. Vernon at 320 E. Main St., Harrisburg at 350 Seright Ste. C and Salem at 1375 W. Whitaker.
